Creative Learning Project for Spring 1 is Moon Zoom!

All our learning will be based around Moon Zoom! In English we will be designing our own alien and writing descriptions about the aliens we have designed. We will also find out facts about the moon and write a non-fiction text about what we have found out. We will look at the book 'Whatever Next!' We will use this as a stimulus for writing and retell this story. We will also look at the book 'The Man on the Moon' and write a diary about being on the moon. In maths we will continue to focus on counting both forwards and backwards and looking at how numbers are made. We will continue to look at adding and subtracting and solving missing number problems. In science we will look at materials and their properties and also look at the solar system. In art we will be making our own solar system in a style based on the artist Kandinsky.
