

Hello,

The Shakespeare team are very excited to have you back in school on Thursday 4th June. We have been working hard to make sure that everything is prepared for your arrival. On returning to school, there will be a number of changes to the usual routines and all of this will be explained clearly to you. One of the key differences, which we have already shared with your families, will be that you might not be back in your usual classroom, and with your usual teacher. To help keep us all safe we will be learning and playing in bubbles. This is the name for small groups of children and teachers which will not change or come into contact with any other group. We will explain more about how learning bubbles will work on Thursday but for now all you need to know is which bubble you are in.



You have been placed into the 'Yellow A' learning bubble and will be based in the 6F classroom with Mr Feather as your teacher.



Arrival

You are asked to arrive at school at 8:45am through the 5/6 gate only – there will be no possibility to arrive via other entrances to school or to spend time on the playground. When you arrive you'll go straight into your classroom and wash your hands. You should have nothing to bring with you to school except a water bottle and if you bring your lunch from home, also a healthy packed lunch in a disposable plastic bag (not a packed lunch box). All items from your packed lunch should be able to be thrown away at the end of your lunch time so we limit the number of items moving between school and your home.

Clothing

You should try to come to school each day in clean clothing. This does not need to be school uniform, however you can still wear this if you wish. The main requirement, is that you should wear sensible footwear and clothing that allows you to take part in physical activity throughout the day. Here are some examples:
