

Expected PE Kit Procedures for All Children

At Shakespeare Primary School, we feel that correct PE kit is essential for children and staff to take part safely and hygienically.

All children are expected to bring the appropriate kit for every PE lesson.

The PE kit we expect is:

- Plain white t-shirt/ polo shirt
- Red shorts (girls may wear plain, black leggings)
- Suitable pumps/ trainers

For outdoor PE, children are also allowed to wear:

- Plain black hooded top
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms

For swimming lessons:

- Boys may wear swimming trunks/ shorts.
- Girls may wear a swimming costume or burqini.
- Children may wear swimming caps, armbands and goggles (optional).

For indoor PE lessons:

- Children should wear shoes and socks to walk around school, but remove them in the hall and store them under the windows at the far side of the hall.

The following applies to all PE lessons including swimming.

All jewellery should be removed from all children. Children who cannot remove earrings must have them taped up. Children are responsible for doing this themselves. For health and safety reasons, members of staff cannot put on/ remove plasters from piercings

On the morning of PE lessons, class teachers will ask all children if they have their kit for their PE lesson that day. Any children who do not, need to have their parents called before 9am. Parents will be asked to bring in their child's kit for their lesson.

At the time of the lesson, any children who do not have full, correct PE kit will receive a kit mark and miss 5 minutes of their playtime. These children's parents/ carers will be spoken to at the end of the day informing them of the importance of correct PE kit and that their child missed part of their playtime as a result of not having correct kit.

When children reach two kit marks, a letter will be posted home from the school office. Teachers/ support staff need to ask the office to do this when a second kit mark is reached. Parents should still be spoken to every time correct kit is not worn.

A further incidence will result in the parent of the child being asked to come into school for a meeting with their class teacher/ Mr Hemingway/ Mr Gorton.

Children who regularly attend school without PE kit, will lose their privileges at after school clubs and have to reapply when they have shown that they are wearing correct kit every week.

Expected PE Kit Procedures for All Staff

At Shakespeare Primary School, we feel that correct PE kit is essential for children and staff to take part safely and hygienically.

All staff are expected to wear the following for all PE lessons:

- Black Shakespeare Primary School Polo
- Red Shakespeare Primary Track Top (optional – teachers only)
- Tracksuit bottoms/ shorts
- Suitable trainers

Where possible, branded kit should always be visible in order to easily identify staff within lessons.

Where PE lessons are taught before lunch, staff may come into work dressed ready for PE, and change into regular work clothing at lunch time.

Where PE lessons are taught in the afternoon, staff must come into work in their regular work clothing in the morning, and change for PE ready for the afternoon.

Staff attending swimming and delivering to a group should also be dressed in their PE kit. Staff not delivering do not need to be wearing PE kit for swimming.
