Creative Learning Project for Autumn 1 is I am Warrior

Our learning will be based around Roman Britain. We will be learning about The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. In English the children will be writing historical stories, play scripts, invitations, menus and letters. In Maths we will be concentrating on place value, addition and subtraction of numbers up to 10,000. In Science we will be learning about electricity. In geography the children will learn about map work and compare Britain and Italy. In Art and DT the children will be designing and making their own shields, helmets, mosaics and Roman food.
