Our Learning Project for Autumn 1 is Pharaohs

We will be investigating the role of the pharaoh within Ancient Egypt. English lessons will focus around novels set in ancient times and use what we learn to create a convincing letter home and diary entry written in role. In Art and DT we will create observational drawings of ancient artefacts as well as making our own canopic jars. All pupils will use our weather station to draw comparisons between the weather in LS9 and the weather in Egypt. We will be using mapping and research skills to explore the location and features of Egypt's most famous landmarks. If you have any expertise in this area or own any artefacts please speak to Mrs Wilson or Mr Feather.

Other Areas of Learning

- Maths- Solving problems involving: place value, the four operations and recall of facts
- PE- netball, Team building skills and Swimming
- RE- Islam and religious festivals around the world
- Science- How does light travel?
