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### **Creative Learning Project for Autumn 2 is Tribal Tales**

Our learning will be based around History and Prehistoric Britain. We will be learning how people lived from The Stone Age to The Iron Age. In English the children will be writing adventures stories, poetry and fact files. In Maths we will be concentrating on place value, addition and subtraction of numbers up to 1000. We will then be learning how to multiply and divide. Children will need to know their 3, 4 and 8 times tables by the end of this term. In Science we will be learning about metals and magnets. In geography the children will learn about map work and the local area. In Art and DT the children will be learning about patterns, designs and structures in Prehistoric Britain and replicate these with their own designs!
