This half term the children of Year 3 will be using the story “Flat Stanley” by Jeff Brown as inspiration for our written work in English, which is focussed around story telling. We will also be looking at non-fiction texts about Rivers as a stimulus for poetry and report writing. In Maths the children will be learning about measurements of length and time. In Science we will be learning about plants. The children will be encouraged to use scientific enquiry to gather information.
