## Our Learning Project for Summer Two is Gallery Rebels

This half term we will be studying four different artists from different eras and exploring their style and technique. Everybody will be creating a 'No place I'd rather be' pointillism painting. We look forward to sharing these with you. In English we will be reading *Escape from Pompeii* and Michael Morpurgo's *Kensuke's Kingdom*. We will use what we read to inspire our writing looking at setting descriptions and alternative endings. In science we will be exploring colour and light through a range of challenging (and slightly messy) experiments.
