Dear Parents and Carers,

Current circumstances regarding Coronavirus guidance are leading to individual children self isolating for up to 14 days whilst their class remain in school. It is important that should this occur their learning journey continues whilst they are staying at home. Many of you used the DB Primary platform for home learning during lockdown and home learning will be similar to that but there will also be higher expectations of how much your child will do each day. This will be appropriate to the age of the child and any additional needs, but some general principles are outlined below:

- Home learning will be provided which should last for the duration of a normal school day.
- Teaching videos will be provided and, across the week, there will be learning in different areas of the school curriculum.
- Children will access their lessons through DB Primary. DB Primary can be accessed directly from our school website.
- All children use DB Primary in school each week and should be able to log in and find their year group community independently. From here they can also email their teacher and send through their work.
- Children will also receive a home learning pack containing activities designed to be completed independently in order to develop their basic skills relevant to their stage of learning and a letter including a timetable of what is expected each day
