Our Learning Project for Autumn 1 is...

Rocks, Relics and Rumbles

How does the earth beneath our feet affect people around the world?

This half term the children in Year Three will be using the story "Escape from Pompeii" by Christina Balit as inspiration for our written work in English, which is focussed around diaries, letters, poetry and scene setting. In Maths, the children will be learning about place value and the four operations. In Science, we will be learning about rocks and soil and the different ways rocks are formed. The children will be encouraged to use scientific enquiry to gather information and record this in an accurate way. In computing we will be exploring databases. In Geography we will learn to describe and understand key aspects of volcanoes and earthquakes.
