Pharaohs

What made the Ancient Egyptians so powerful?

This half term we will be reading, 'The Search for Tutankhamen' and 'Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx'. Our new-found knowledge will be used to write an article for the school website and a quest story. In geography we will be learning how to use mapping and research skills to explore the location and features of Egypt's most famous landmarks including the River Nile. We are looking forward to another incredible art project, this time inspired by cubism. We will develop our skills using pastels and geometric shapes to design our very own Ancient Egyptian nemes. In Design and Technology we will be trying to take a leaf out of the Ancient Egyptians book to design and create an irrigation system for our raised beds inspired by the shadouf.
