Our Learning Project for Spring One is...

Gallery Rebels

Can you change the world with a paintbrush, a thought or an idea?

Colours collide, melting together on the canvas: an impression of light, a rage of red, a lobster perched on a telephone. Come and find out about the bizarre and eccentric minds of the gallery rebels. Art can be an act of rebellion. Can you change the world with a paintbrush, a thought, or an idea? In Art, we'll work our way through the artistic movements up to the period of Pop Art which smashed its way onto the scene in the 1950's. We'll learn about the artists who stepped away from the norms of their period, challenged people's perceptions and took their art into a new direction. As well as creating our own Pop Art pieces, in DT we'll design, build and evaluate our own easel type structures to display them at the end of the project. In computing, we'll create a multimedia presentation, backed by our own soundtracks created using Garage Band and write our own scripts in English. Alongside this, in English, we will delve into the world of Stanley Yelnats as we read the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar, writing narratives and character descriptions.
