Our Learning Project for Spring 2 is...

Ancient Greece

How have the Ancient Greeks affected the world we live in today?

We will be using our historical skills to learn about how Ancient Greece was split into city states, each with their own unique differences but, also shared similarities. We'll be able to explain how we know so much about the world of Ancient Greece through the study of history and link it back to our previous learning on the Ancient Egyptian civilisation we learned about last half term. As historians, we will be building our knowledge of empire through historical enquiry and linking this learning to our golden theme of democracy. Our new-found knowledge will be used to help in our English lessons, where we will be reading Ancient Greek myths and writing our own sets of instructions about how to become a mythical hero. In geography, we will learn to locate Greece on a map of Europe and study the location of several Ancient Greek city states. We are also looking forward to another incredible art project, as we design and paint a piece of artwork based on Ancient Greek vases. We will develop our skills using repeating patterns, painting details and using a wash to add colour to our piece of art.
