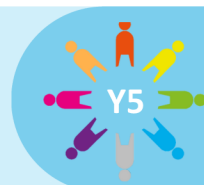


Life Cycles

Attendance has been impacted by sickness absence this half term.

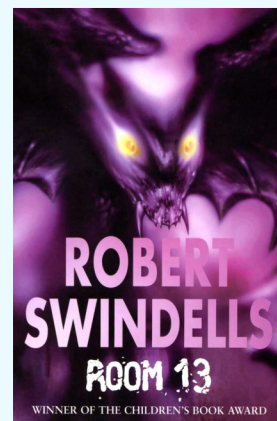


Whole school attendance so far this academic year is **96%**.
