Spelling



We are learning that the apostrophe usually replaces a vowel when writing contractions (e.g. could + not = couldn't)

We are learning that different words use different suffixes when pluralised.

When a word ends in a consonant and then a 'y' – the y changes to an 'i' + 'es'.

We are using different strategies to practise spellings.
