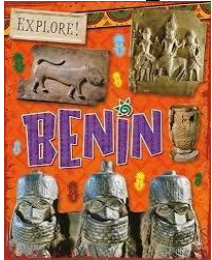

Spelling



We are learning spellings which use a hyphen.
