Spelling

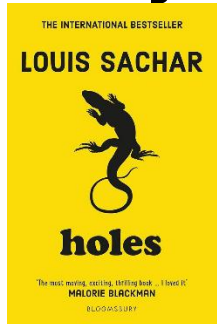


We are using different strategies for learning words.
