# Tricky word support

	Tricky word	Why is it tricky?	How to teach
Y1 Spr1 wk1	<u>any</u>	The grapheme 'a' makes the sound <b>e</b> . <i>This is a rare GPC.</i>	<b>Say:</b> This is the tricky bit. Then ...  Point to 'a'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>e</b> .
Y1 Spr1 wk2	<u>who</u>	The word 'who' has two tricky parts: the digraph 'wh' makes the sound <b>h</b> and the grapheme 'o' makes the sound <b>oo</b> (as in 'food'). <i>These are rare GPCs.</i>	 Point to 'wh'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>h</b> . Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>oo</b> .
Y1 Spr1 wk4	<u>thought</u>	The grapheme 'ough' makes the sound <b>or</b> . <i>This is a rare GPC.</i>	 Point to 'ough'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>or</b> .
Y1 Au2 wk4	<u>water</u>	The grapheme 'a' makes the sound <b>or</b> and is not yet decodable.	 Point to 'a'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>or</b> .
