Spelling



We are learning the rules for when we add the suffix **est** to a root word

Spelling rules

Drop the 'e' and add the suffix 'est'

Common Exception Word support

clothes	The grapheme 'o' makes the 'oa' sound The 'es' makes the 's' sound
sugar	The grapheme 's' makes the 'sh' sound The digraph 'ar' makes the 'er' sound
sure	The grapheme 's' makes the 'sh' sound The trigraph 'ure' makes the 'your' sound
busy	The grapheme 'u' makes the 'i' sound The grapheme 's' makes the 'z' sound

We are adding 'y' to these words

scare	shine	noise	ice

Spelling rules

Drop the 'e' and add the 'y'
