## Spelling



We are reviewing these graphemes and phonemes (GPC) **ie (igh) i-e o (oa) o-e**  
We reviewing the tricky words **one says were here**  
We are reading and writing words containing these GPC  
We are reading and writing sentences containing these GPCs and tricky words

## English



We are continuing to explore the book 'The Last Wolf'  
We are answering retrieval questions focusing on '**Who**' and '**What**'  
We are looking at the words **pounced lurked hunting**  
We are writing a character description for the wolf in the story

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## Tricky Word support

<u>were</u>	<p>The trigraph 'ere' makes the sound <b>ur</b>. This is a rare GPC.</p>	<p>Point to 'ere'. <b>Say:</b> This trigraph says <b>ur</b>.</p>
<u>here</u>	<p>The trigraph 'ere' makes the sound <b>ear</b> and is not yet decodable.</p>	<p>Point to 'ere'. <b>Say:</b> This trigraph says <b>ear</b>.</p>
<u>says</u>	<p>The digraph 'ay' makes the sound <b>e</b>. This is a rare GPC.</p>	<p>Point to 'ay'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>e</b>.</p>
<u>one</u>	<p>The word 'one' has two tricky parts: the grapheme 'o' makes the sounds <b>w-u</b> and the digraph 'ne' makes the sound <b>n</b>. *This is a rare GPC</p>	<p>Point to 'o'. <b>Say:</b> This grapheme says <b>wu</b>. Point to 'ne'. <b>Say:</b> This digraph says <b>n</b>.</p>
