We are learning to add the suffix **ness ment ful**

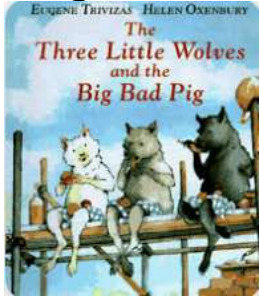
We are recapping the rule for when a word ends in a 'y' and when to swap it for an 'i' and when to not
